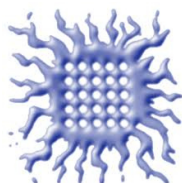

CONFERENCE VENUE and TRAVEL INFORMATION

XXV Conference of the Serbian Crystallographic Society will be held on June 21–23rd 2018, in Bajina Bašta, hotel “DRINA” (<http://zepterhoteldrina.com/>; <http://www.taragreen.rs/hotel-drina.html>).

Bajina Bašta is a town located in western Serbia. The town lies in the valley of the Drina River at the eastern edge of Tara National Park. The shortest route from Belgrade to Bajina Bašta is *via* Valjevo, and it is 166 km long. Between Valjevo and Bajina Bašta there is a 60 km long route *via* Debelo Brdo. From Novi Sad to Bajina Bašta the trip is 207 km long, and you can go *via* Šabac and Valjevo. From Kragujevac to Bajina Bašta the trip is 170 km long, and you can go *via* Čačak and Užice. There are also direct bus lines to Bajina Bašta from Belgrade at 8⁰⁰, 9⁰⁰, 11²⁵, 15¹⁵ and 17³⁰; Novi Sad at 6⁰⁵ and 6⁴³; Kragujevac at 11⁴⁵.
