
CONFERENCE VENUE

XXIX Conference of the Serbian Crystallographic Society will be held on June 27–28th 2024, at Ruma, hotel "Borkovac" (https://borkovac.org/).

Hotel Borkovac is ideally located in the Ruma excursion area, just 3 km from the city center of Ruma, 50 km west of Belgrade, and only 35 km from Novi Sad. This location allows for various activities such as excursions, sports, and visits to the monasteries of Fruska Gora and wineries. Additionally, the hotel offers a national restaurant and a spa center with a pool, jacuzzis, steam baths, salt rooms, and a Finnish sauna.

In the heart of Srem, the municipality of Ruma represents a wealth inscribed in history, touching periods from the Roman Empire to the present day. Known for its educational institutions, which continue a long history of education in this region, Ruma is also a center for food production and agricultural development, reflecting its importance in economic and social terms. Gradually, during the period of the Roman Empire, military camps that emerged in these areas developed into settlements, and the population adopted Roman culture, enriching their own identity. In addition to Sirmium, which was exceptionally significant in this region, Ruma highlighted its importance as a craft center, educational center, and religious sanctuary.

The cultural heritage of Ruma is reflected in numerous monuments that testify to the culture, history, and famous personalities of the city. From archaeological sites like Gomolava and Basijana to monuments from the Secession period, the cultural richness of Ruma is diverse and dynamic. The Homeland Museum of Ruma represents the wealth of the history of this region through over 10,000 exhibits, while monuments such as the Monument of Statues, Monument of the Revolution, "Children with a Book," and others are significant for preserving and promoting the cultural-historical heritage of the city.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Authors are kindly requested to prepare their abstracts according to the template available on the website (https://skd.org.rs/wp-content/uploads/2024/04/Obrazac_Template_SKD2024.docx).

The abstracts should be submitted electronically via email by May 3, 2024, to the address **serb.cryst.soc@gmail.com**. In the accompanying text, please indicate the preferred method of presentation (oral or poster presentation). Name the file: **Lastname_First-word-of-title**.

All submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee, which reserves the right to suggest a different type of presentation from the one proposed by the author (the number of posters is limited). Notification of the status of the abstracts and the type of presentation will be provided no later than **May 15**, **2024**. The same author can be the presenting author for a maximum of two abstracts.

The dimensions of the poster should not exceed 70×100 cm.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT HOTEL ACCOMMODATION, EXTENDED REGISTRATION FEE, AND REGULAR REGISTRATION FEE

EXTENDED REGISTRATION FEE FOR CONFERENCE PARTICIPANTS AND ACCOMPANYING PERSONS

The organizers have made a pre-reservation of accommodation at the "Borkovac" Hotel in Ruma. To provide conference participants with accommodation at preferential rates, the organizers have enabled payment for hotel accommodation through the Serbian Crystallographic Society in the form of an extended fee (Table 1). Accommodation for accompanying persons at the "Borkovac" hotel at preferential rates is also facilitated through the Serbian Crystallographic Society (Table 2).

The hotel accommodation includes **single rooms** (with a double bed), **double rooms** (with a double bed and a single bed), and **triple rooms** (with a double bed and two single beds). Organizers will reserve the desired room type based on currently available capacities. If participants and accompanying persons wish to book accommodation independently or through an agency, rather than through the Serbian Crystallographic Society by selecting the extended fee option, then the organizers **cannot guarantee accommodation at preferential rates!**

REGULAR CONFERENCE FEE

The regular conference fee is 60 EUR, except for doctoral students (50 EUR). You can submit a request for a Pro-forma invoice on the conference website (https://skd.org.rs/conferences/current-conference/registration-fee-and-accommodation/). This type of fee covers participation in the Conference, the gala dinner, and the excursion. The fee cannot be paid at the Conference itself. The deadline for payment of this fee is May 26, 2024. When making the payment, be sure to include the proforma invoice number as the payment reference.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

If conference participants and accompanying individuals wish to reserve accommodation independently or through an agency at the Borkovac Hotel, **rather than through the Serbian Crystallographic Society by selecting the extended fee option, the organizers cannot guarantee accommodation at discounted rates!** The organizers have made preliminary reservations for all rooms, so the option to reserve accommodation at the Borkovac Hotel at economic rates through the individual organization by participants will only be available after **May 15, 2024.**

Conference participants and accompanying individuals who wish to reserve accommodation independently have many hotels, hostels, and apartments available near the Borkovac Hotel, where the Conference will take place.
