



CONFERENCE VENUE



The 29th SCS Conference will take place on June 27th and 28th, 2024, in Ruma, at Hotel "Borkovac" (https://borkovac.org/), Orlovićeva bb. The coordinates of Hotel "Borkovac" are 45°02'02.8"N, 19°49'09.3"E.

Ruma is located 50 km west of Belgrade and 35 km from Novi Sad. Thanks to its convenient location and road infrastructure, Ruma can be reached from Belgrade via the E75 highway, and from Kragujevac via A1 and E75.

Conference participants who are guests of Hotel "Borkovac" can park their cars in the hotel's parking lot, which is free of charge for all conference participants and hotel visitors.

During the period from June 28th to August 30th, Ruma will host an exceptionally diverse program called "Ruma Cultural Summer" (https://vojvodina.travel/rumsko-kulturno-leto-ruma/). This event includes concerts, theater performances, visual arts, and literary events organized by cultural institutions. The beginning of the event is scheduled for Friday, June 28th, at 9 PM, with a concert on the City Square performed by the Zrenjanin Philharmonic Orchestra. Additionally, there will be concerts by well-known musicians, tamburitza music, schlager music, a night market, and the traditional Rumfest – a family festival of knowledge and gastronomy.

Across from the hotel, at the Borkovac resort in Ruma, there is a modern sports and leisure complex – "Borkovac Pool". This complex offers two pools - a large pool measuring 25 m \times 50 m and a small children's pool measuring 18 m \times 10 m. Besides swimming, visitors can enjoy the café and sweets. Additionally, the pool regularly organizes various entertainment events and night swimming sessions.
